General Information

ITEMS NOT TO BRING

Listed below are items that should **NOT** be packed. While not 100% inclusive, do not bring these items with you:

- Any item prohibited by L-W High School Dist. #210 rules (see below)
- Gaming Devices
- Candles or incense
- Matches or lighters
- Strobe lights
- Sport/energy drinks or other liquids (does not include toiletries or medication covered by the medication authorization)
- Any item that would cause a financial or personal hardship to replace in the event it becomes lost or broken.

District #210 Prohibited Activities

The Lincoln-Way tradition of excellence has been established primarily through the high standards of respect, cooperation, personal/organizational pride, and self-discipline. Students are reminded that department travel is considered an extension of the Lincoln-Way campuses. All relevant Lincoln-Way District #210 school rules will be enforced. Prohibited behavior or activity includes, but is not limited to:

- Dangerous weapons (carrying or possessing any type of article designed to do bodily harm, including all types of knives or any other dangerous item) or look alike weapons
- Deceitful activity (lying or attempting to deceive)
- Possession, use, distribution, or sale of drugs, look alike drugs, drug paraphernalia, controlled substances, alcohol, and tobacco or tobacco products
- Gambling (any games of chance involving wagering)
- Insubordination (resisting authority or lack of respect for those in authority)
- Obscenity (obscene, profane, or vulgar language either written, oral, or expressed in symbols)
- Inappropriate social conduct (loud, boisterous conversation or other attention seeking behavior/any type of public display of affection/intimacy and physical contact)
- Stealing (theft of school or personal property)
- ALL forms of individual initiating, bullying, humiliation, and/or “hazing” are forbidden.

IMPORTANT: Rule Violations and Consequences

VIOLATIONS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. ALL violations or suspected violations of L-W District #210 or ‘LWMB’ trip rules will be reported to the Band Director(s) for investigation and enforcement. Such enforcement will be appropriate to the violation and may range from a simple reprimand to being sent home at the parent’s expense, and/or other penalties.
