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PURPOSE: This course offers an introductory experience of music theory and composition using computers and synthesizers. You will be learning and creating music through structured assignments with the opportunity of incorporating your own creative ideas.

CLASSROOM RULES

- ◆ All rules and guidelines explained in the Lincoln-Way West High School Parent-Student Handbook apply in this classroom.
- ◆ Attendance will follow the same guidelines as stated in the Parent-Student Handbook. Most of your assignments will be completed in class, it is crucial that you are here.
- ◆ Students must come to class ready to participate (have homework, materials, etc.) and be IN YOUR ASSIGNED SEAT when class begins. Students must always stay on task in their designated areas. Completing work for other classes, engaging in non-class related conversations, using the computers for work other than this course will NOT be tolerated at any time.
- ◆ No food, drinks, gum, or candy is permitted in the lab at any time!
- ◆ All work must be turned in ON TIME (assignments will be dropped 5 points for each day late). Missed quizzes and tests due to illness or excused absence must be made up on the day of your return; unexcused absences will receive NO credit. Late assignments due to illness or excused absence must be turned in on the day that you return.
- ◆ All tests, quizzes and assignments done on manuscript must be completed in ***pencil*** (points off the final grade for work done in pen)
- ◆ Use the lab station that you were assigned--do not use other students' equipment. Report any damage or loss immediately to the instructor. You may be held responsible for damage or loss.
- ◆ 2 participation points are given every day. Any infraction of the above rules will result in the loss of one or both of these points for that day.
- ◆ Cheating will not be tolerated. The first offense will result in a zero for that assignment; further infractions will result in a zero for the course and disciplinary action.

MANDATORY MATERIALS

Headphones and adapter-all students must provide their own set of headphones daily. If you use iPod (or similar sized) headphones, you must use an adapter. Both the adapter and headphones must be in class every day. Failure to bring either will result in loss of participation points for the day and silent composition

MUSIC PROJECTS:

The following is the list of music projects that will be graded over the semester. Projects that cover two weeks will be worth **20 points**

Week 1 & 2 – Pachelbel Canon variations – **20 points**

Week 3 & 4 – Ostinato – **20 points**

Week 5 & 6 – Diminished chords – **20 points**

Week 7 & 8 – Jazz project – **20 points**

Week 9 – begin working on commercial

EXTRA CREDIT FOR THE QUARTER – compose another Ostinato based in a minor key - 20 points max

Week 10 – finish working on commercial – **20 points**

Week 11 & 12 –commercial #2 – **20 points**

Week 13 & 14 – Movie trailers – **20 points**

Week 15 & 16 – ‘Political’ ad – **20 points**

Week 17 & 18 – COMPOSE YOUR FINAL FULL LENGTH MOVIE TRAILER – **100 points!** – Due on day of final!

EXTRA CREDIT FOR THE QUARTER – compose another ‘political’ ad – 20 points max
